

Basic procedures for a user to share one sub-directory with other user under AFS file system

- 1) Verify/confirm that the users have access to Fénix AFS system activated.
(Use DSI link: <https://selfservice.dsi.tecnico.ulisboa.pt>)
- 2) For example, user ist1111 wants to share folder ~/exp
- 3) ist1111 creates the folder ~/exp with the command
> mkdir ~/exp
- 4) verify AFS permissions with command
> fs la ~/exp
- 5) gives write permission, for example, to user ist1222 with the command
> fs sa ~/exp ist1222 write
- 6) repete 4) to confirm new permissions
- 7) ist1111 can redraw the folder access to ist1222 using the command
> fs sa ~/exp ist1222 none
- 8) Finally ist1111 user should give to ist1222 user the complete path to the shared folder ~/exp.
For that user ist1111 should go inside shared folder, and give the command:
> pwd
